New Creation, New Exodus, and New Humanity *The Gospel of John*

Israel at the time of Jesus (163 BC - 135 AD) hoped to become God's *new humanity* again. They understood that God would have to bring it about in the form of a New Creation and New Exodus because Creation and Exodus were already thematically related events, linked by the common idea of *God creating His true humanity*. This is why Jesus interacted so much with themes and motifs of new humanity.
