## John 11:5

<sup>5</sup> Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister [Mary] and Lazarus...

[But Lazarus died and was buried for four days]



### John 11:32 – 36

<sup>32</sup> Therefore, when Mary came where Jesus was, she saw him, and fell at his feet, saying to him, 'Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died.' <sup>33</sup> When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in spirit and was troubled, <sup>34</sup> and said, 'Where have you laid him?' They said to him, 'Lord, come and see.' <sup>35</sup> Jesus wept. <sup>36</sup> So the Jews were saying, 'See how he loved him!'



### John 11:37 – 40

<sup>37</sup> But some of them said, 'Could not this man, who opened the eyes of the blind man, have kept this man also from dying?' <sup>38</sup> So Jesus, again being deeply moved within, came to the tomb. Now it was a cave, and a stone was lying against it. <sup>39</sup> Jesus said, 'Remove the stone.' Martha, the sister of the deceased, said to him, 'Lord, by this time there will be a stench, for he has been dead four days.' <sup>40</sup> Jesus said to her, 'Did I not say to you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?'



### John 11:41 – 44

<sup>41</sup> So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised his eyes, and said, 'Father, I thank You that You have heard me. <sup>42</sup> I knew that You always hear me; but because of the people standing around I said it, so that they may believe that You sent me.' <sup>43</sup> When he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice, 'Lazarus, come forth.' <sup>44</sup> The man who had died came forth, bound hand and foot with wrappings, and his face was wrapped around with a cloth. Jesus said to them, 'Unbind him, and let him go.'




