FOREWORD—Just as the first was good, and the second better, the third Levittown will be the best of all. Located just 30 minutes from the City Hall in Philadelphia, it boasts the finest homes, a beautiful swimming pool, tennis courts, and a great many other things to give you a complete suburban experience. It is so convenient to be a suburbanite here with only 20 minutes' ride to all the conveniences of the City, and yet with only 10 minutes' ride to the beach and the mountains. The new homes will be completed by the end of the year, and will be ready for occupancy by the beginning of 1950. They are not ordinary suburbia; they will be better by the measure.

SHOPPING—A large regional shopping center is the heart of Levittown. At the writing here, Barnes & Co., and Food Fair have already opened an extensive department store. There will be a dry goods and other department store, drug store, and dozens of others of both the large and small variety. In the heart of Levittown, we think the finest shopping center ever built in this country. Special attention has been given to lighting, landscaping, parking, etc. You have your choice of a completely new shopping center or use the existing shopping center.

THE HOUSES—Three distinctly different houses are now being submitted. In the advertisement you will see the three, and get the best one that you want. 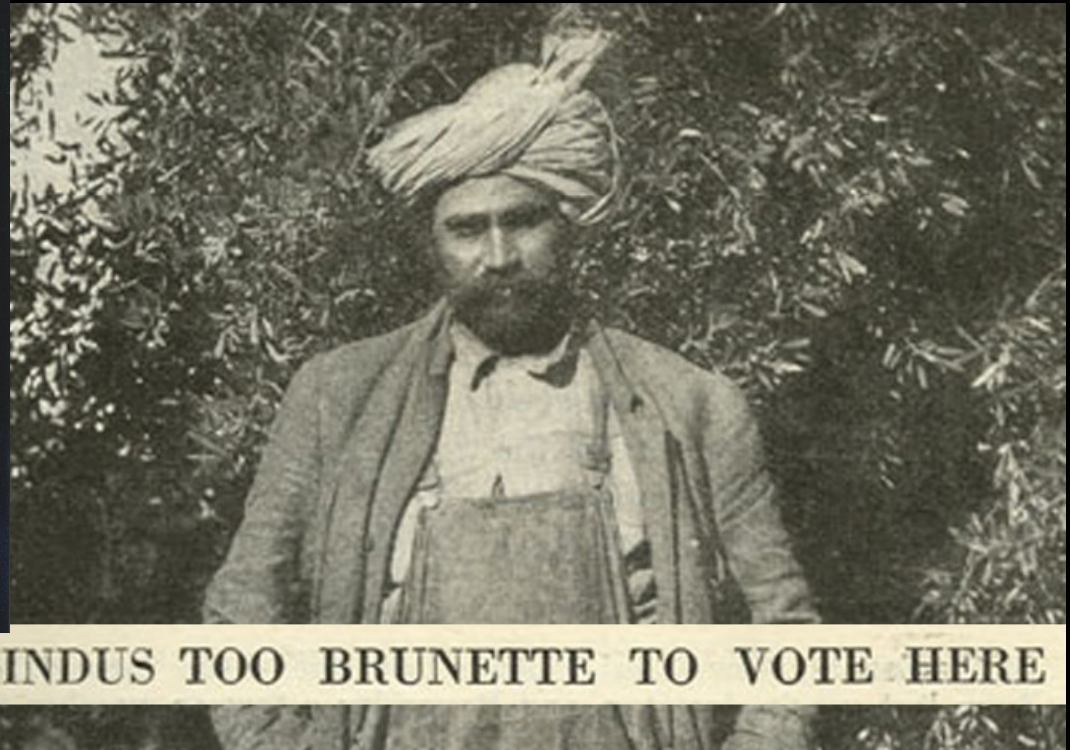
The Legal Construction of Whiteness: Ozawa v. United States (1922)



Takao Ozawa vs United States

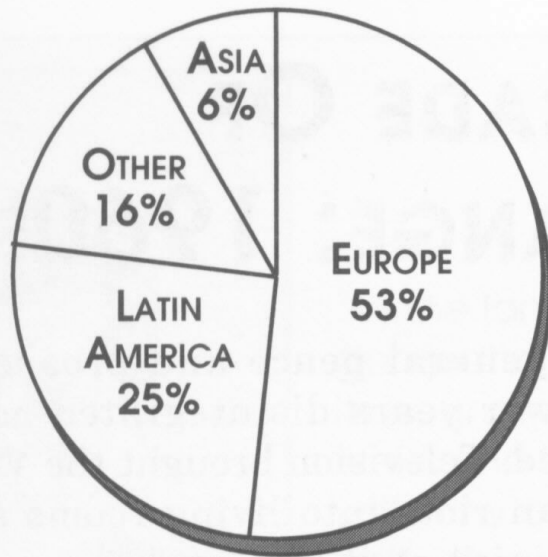


The Legal Construction of Whiteness: United States v. Bhagat Thind (1923)



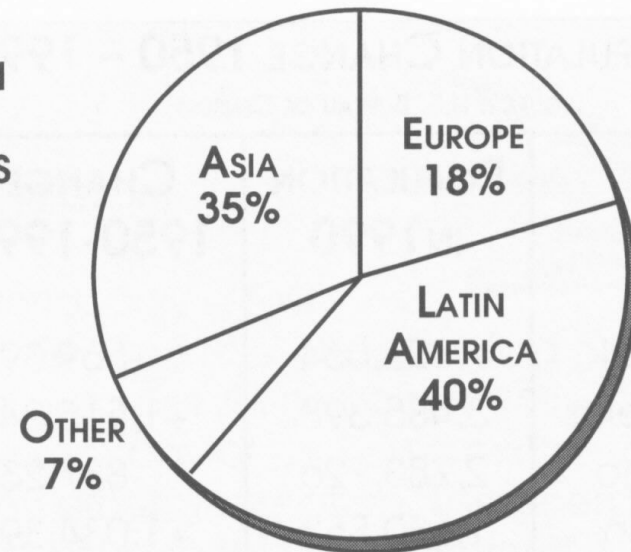

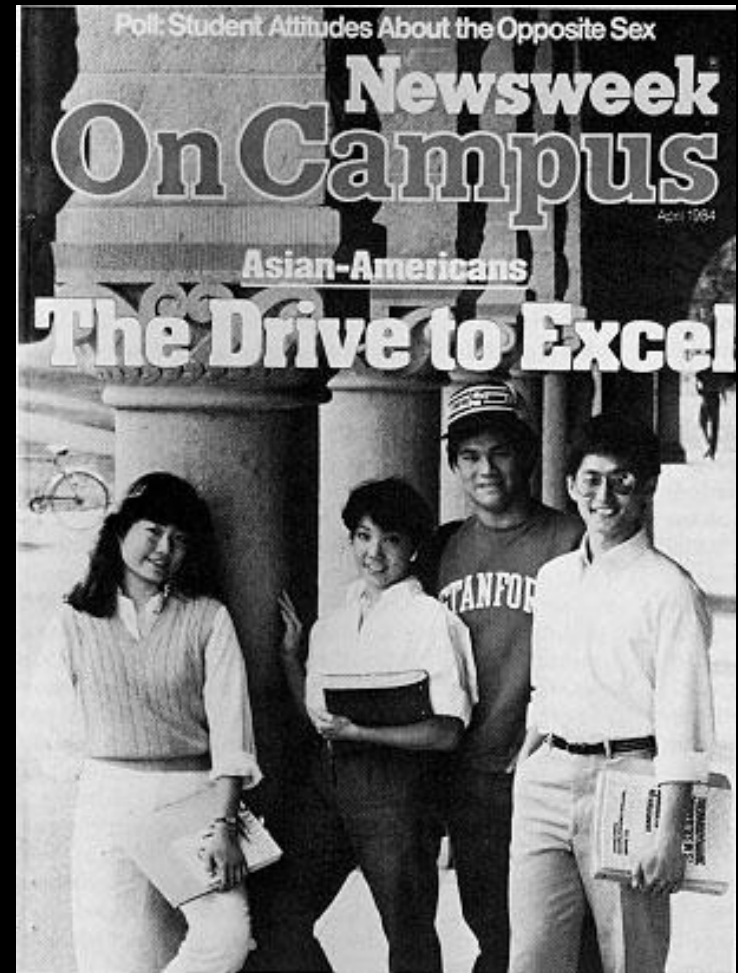

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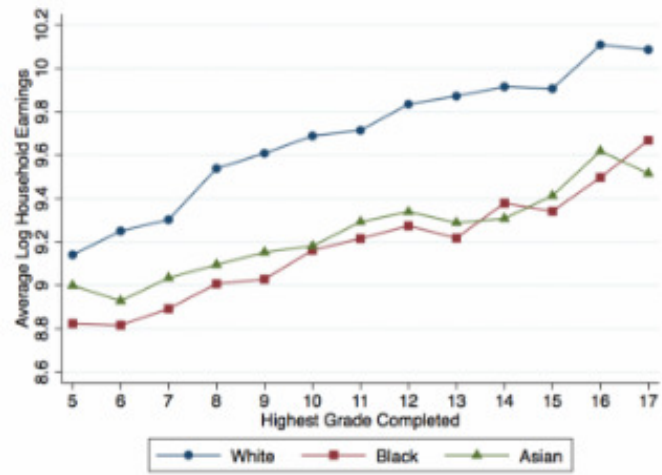
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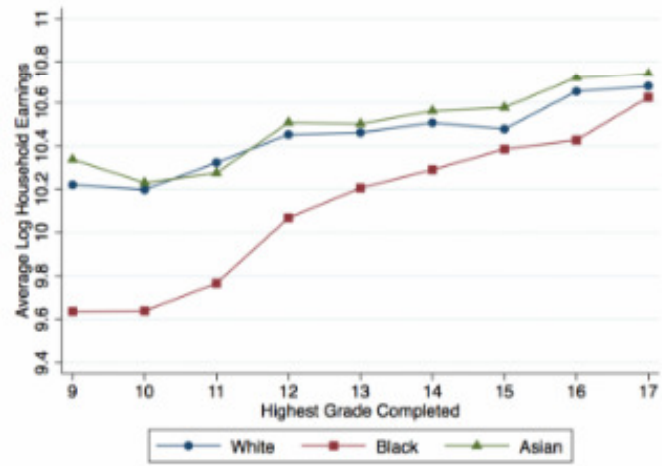

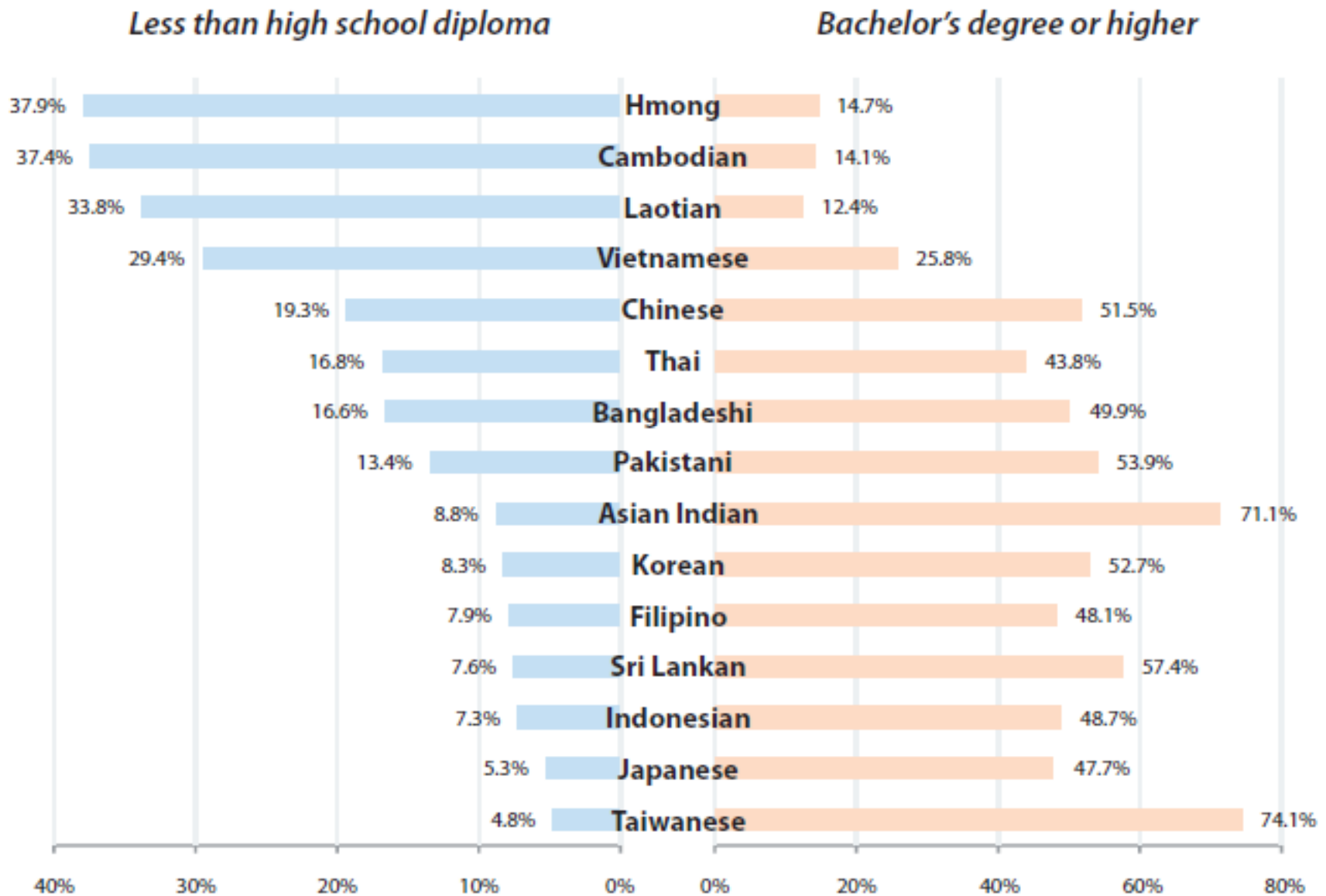
