One with a God who clearly loves and values every human being

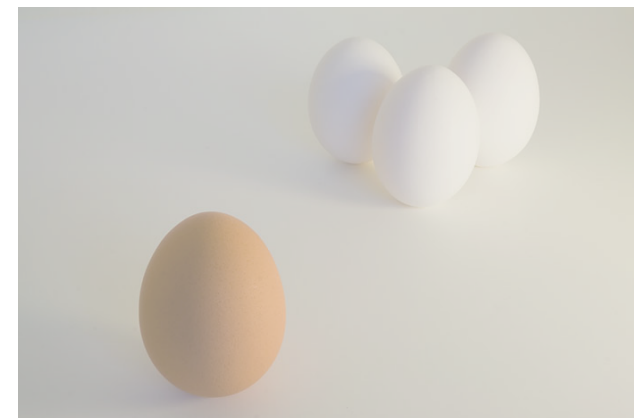


One that connects us to a supernatural source of love
